

AWSC Meeting, September 19, 2020

- July Chairman of the Board Letter from WSO
- Revised Budget restricts World Service Office (WSO) Volunteer and Staff travel through the end of the year, extends furloughs, and limits hiring.
- Contributions for June 2020 were \$509,058 which is \$345,472 (211%) more than actual June 2019. (Awesome!) Budgeted contributions for June were \$335,732 (194%) above budget. Year to date contributions are still above budget by \$615,206 (65%) due to the increase in contributions from the Special Appeal from the fellowship and the bequest in February.
- The response from the members, groups, Districts, and Areas to our Special Appeal was exciting to see and so very appreciated. We knew we could depend on all of you to help when it was most needed. The Finance Committee continues to keep a thoughtful eye on expenses, and we wish to thank to the Staff for controlling our expenses. Although the contributions were above the budgeted amount for June, we are not out of the woods. There is still a projected deficit of \$420,000 through the end of December 2020. Please continue your contributions to WSO if you are able. - Electronic Meeting Work Group Update
- After performing a KBDM, the EMWG has concluded that electronic meetings are Al-Anon groups and are asked to adhere to the same policies that apply to all Al-Anon groups. The EMWG is evaluating all the considerations related to defining electronic meetings as Al-Anon groups, which include electronic meetings having a Group Representative (GR) with duties and responsibilities as currently defined by the 2018-2021 Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual (P-24/27) version.
- The 61st Annual World Service Conference has been scheduled for Monday, April 12 through Friday, April 16, 2021 in Tarrytown, New York. Conference members will visit Stepping Stones during the week. The Annual OPEN Board of Trustees Meeting will be held the afternoon of Friday, April 16. Saturday April 17, 70th Anniversary Banquet will be held.
