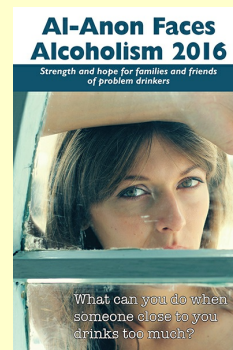

An Area Archives depends on articles or events from your group as the primary source for the collection. This July is a perfect time to search within your group for items of interest. Here are a few suggestions: early correspondence from members that pioneered your group, list of first officers with a description of the positions held, registration and the group formed date (the group formed date is different from the registration date as very often, groups form and then register later), flyers from local events, describe how "other than English" or "special need" members are served, anniversary celebrations, local skits, articles published in *The Forum* or other Al-Anon literature that are specific to the locale, or maybe just some humorous recovery stories.
