Interested in learning how others groups function as a community? Members from groups share on this topic as well as on the structure of Al-Anon, becoming a Group Representative, and the need for a GR and their duties.

The 2015 Membership Survey results are in!

A record 8,517 Al-Anon members participated in the survey, compared to 3,232 in the last Membership Survey in 2012. With this larger sample, we can be even more confident about the reliability of the findings.

In 2015, results show the average age in Al-Anon reached 60, the highest yet; while, the percentage of females in Al-Anon fell to 83%, the lowest yet.

Across the board, Al-Anon members reported improvements in their health and functioning, after attending Al-Anon.

Ninety-two percent of the survey respondents said their lives have been very positively affected from being an Al-Anon member, and an additional 6% said their lives have been somewhat positively affected.

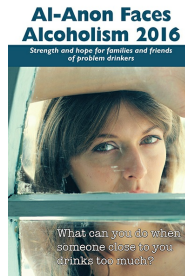
They may think: "What if I ask, and they say no?" Or, "What if I just leave them without asking, and then someone gets upset with me?"
