

## How to greatly increase your chances of being published in *The Forum*



**Alateen sharings needed**

- Go to [al-anon.org](http://al-anon.org).
- Click on "Members' Site" on the right side of the screen.
- From the menu, select "Send your sharing."
- Enter your group name, followed by AFG as your password. (Example: Easy Does It AFG or mondayafg).



## Did you know...

It is possible to handle group business without a bank account. Establishing a group budget form can assist in this process. Use of a simple ledger or notebook can help keep track of all monies coming in from Seventh Tradition and literature sales and monies going out for expenses like rent or GR reimbursement for attendance to the Assembly. Groups have shared with us that they sometimes alter their schedule of payments to allow for more frequent contributions to local service arms to avoid accumulating large sums of cash. For example, donations to the District or AIS can be completed monthly instead of quarterly.

It is not recommended that group expenses be paid from any member's personal savings/checking account because there will not be a record of the transaction for the group to register without viewing the member's complete statement. Groups have shared that purchasing money orders is an inexpensive and convenient alternative as they can be purchased in local grocery and retail stores. Some groups use cash to purchase literature directly from their local Literature Distribution Center and pick up the order to avoid paying postal fees. Others use a pre-paid debit card to order CAL online.

Our shared experience continues to tell us to talk to each other and reason things out. Let's arm ourselves with the facts, participate in due diligence and utilize our Al-Anon tools and principles as our guide.
